


MEDICAL INTERVENTIONS IN AFRICA:

- Networks of medical technopolitics that connects knowledge, technology and personnel between Africa and Israel.
- 2. The intervention embedded in a geocultural discourse in which Africa was dislocated in Israel's geopolitical imagination. Africa's dislocation was also part of a wider epistemological system oriented "inward" toward Jewish Bodies from Africa.
