


#### ERASMUS + 2014 - 2020

- The EU programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe
- 14,7 billion € for all sectors
- Opportunities for:
  - students/individuals (mobility, training)
  - organisations (projects)
- Managed by the International Relations Office (DOWA)

#### CBHE OBJECTIVES

The aim of these projects is to support eligible <a href="Partner Countries">Partner Countries</a> to:

- modernise, internationalise and increase access to higher education
- address the challenges facing their HE institutions and systems
- voluntarily converge with EU development in HE
- increase cooperation with the EU
- promote people to people contacts, intercultural awareness, and understanding.





#### <u>CBHE</u>

- National projects or multi-country projects
- Budget: 500 000 1 000 000 €, duration 24 to 36 months
- Consortia: universities but also non-academic partners
- Deadline: February 2020 (last call in current programme)



## Partner Countries Neighbouring the EU




